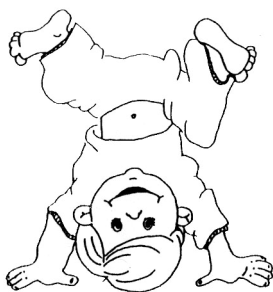


At Tumble Time Gymnastics

Small Fries

Class Length: 45 minutes

Class Length: 1 hour class

Mixed Fries advance to a 1 hour class using basic gymnastics to accomplish challenging skills, as well as improve more body awareness and improve listening skills

Kinder Spuds

5 yr olds

Class Length: 1 hour class

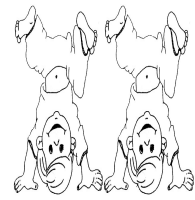

This is a list of guidelines and policies that we feel will be helpful in making your experience at Tumble Time a pleasant and positive one. Please read them carefully.

Gym Guidelines

1. Please be on time to deliver and pick up your child. Also, caution your child to wait inside while waiting to be picked up.
2. Please do not bring your child to class if he/she is ill.
3. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for movement.
4. Please ask your child if he/she needs to use the restroom before class.
5. Gum, food and drinks are not permitted in class.
6. We cannot be responsible for any items that your child leaves. Encourage them to leave toys, etc. in the car. Check for socks, coats, etc. before leaving.
7. Our waiting room can become a very busy place. Please keep these things in mind:
 - Supervise all children carefully
 - Have your child clean up any toys, crayons, etc. he/she has used, as well as any **food crumbs or spilt beverages**
 - Do not let children bang on the windows
 - Do not allow children to jump or climb on furniture
8. Parents may come in the gym with cameras at any time.

Parent Participation Classes

1. Please stay with your child at all times.
2. Please keep your attitude toward your child and the activities they are involved in as positive as possible. Be aware of the "no" word and try to find positive reinforcements for your child.
3. Your teacher will not interfere with parents when they choose to discipline their child. However, please keep in mind that we want your child's time with us to be a fun and positive experience.

Office Guidelines & Priority Dates 2009-2010

Class Tuition: Class tuition is due by the given priority date for each term to secure your space. If you have not paid for classes by the priority date you forfeit your space in your current class for the next term. To ensure that your child maintains their spot in their given class, please pay your tuition on or before the following priority dates:

Term 2: October 12, 2009

Term 3: January 4, 2010

Term 4: March 22, 2010

Term 5: May 24, 2010

Refunds: Should it become impossible for your child to complete a session due to prolonged illness or injury, please notify our office immediately. A refund may be considered, effective on the date of notification. Refunds will be issued in the form of a credit applicable to any Tumble Time or Magic Tumble Bus activity. **Occasional absences are non-refundable and non-transferable. Registration Fees are NON REFUNDABLE. NO REFUNDS ARE GIVEN!**

Makeup Classes: We allow student make-ups when available. Any make-ups need to be scheduled ahead of time. Some class times may not be available due to full enrollment. It would also be helpful if you could notify us when your child will be absent so we can open those times for make-ups.

Changing/Dropping Classes: Should you need to change your class time because your child needs to move to the next age class or because of changes in personal schedule, please contact the office.

Once your child is enrolled in a class, that space is theirs until we are otherwise notified or if you do not pay tuition by the given priority dates for each term. If your child is not returning or needs to switch classes please notify the front desk.

Sometimes, because of enrollment, it is necessary for **Tumble Time** to drop or add classes within the current schedule. We reserve the right to cancel any class due to low enrollment.

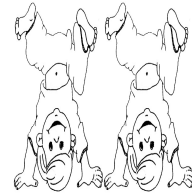

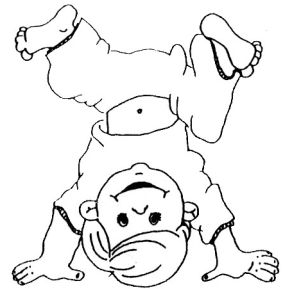
