March Tuition Options

- A. Drop-in **\$9.00**
- B. Monthly **\$35.00**

Discounts: Second child receives a 10% discount. Place all payments in the Magic Tumble Bus mailbox at your child's center. Plan B covers one month. In each month students will receive 3-5 lessons. Tuition will not be prorated.

* Payment is expected the first week of every month. If the balance has not been paid by the second week of the month, the child may not be permitted to participate in our gymnastics classes and payment is still due. Cancellations are accepted by written notice or by calling our office to notify us of any changes.
